

# Minutes of Committee Meeting 30 November 2017

The following topics were discussed.

### 1. The purchase of an external hard drive to back up the club laptop.

This was agreed by the committee as a worthwhile purchase. This will be put to the club members for approval.

Action: Chris McGinley to recommend a suitable hard drive to meet the requirements.

### 2. Purchase of a lead to connect the club projector to a Mac laptop.

This was agreed by the committee as a worthwhile purchase.

Action: Chris McGinley to arrange purchase the lead.

#### 3. Christmas Exhibition 2017.

D Greenwood raised the issue that the club had not organised a Christmas Exhibition. It was agreed that there was insufficient to organise the event and that there would not be Christmas Exhibition 2017.

### 4. Bacup Camera Club Centenary Anniversary.

## 6. Appointment of Auditors.

## 7. Club Annual Competition Rules.

It is proposed that print entries are to include a DPI of the image for use on the clubs website. This is to be discussed at a future Special General Meeting.
